STEM day

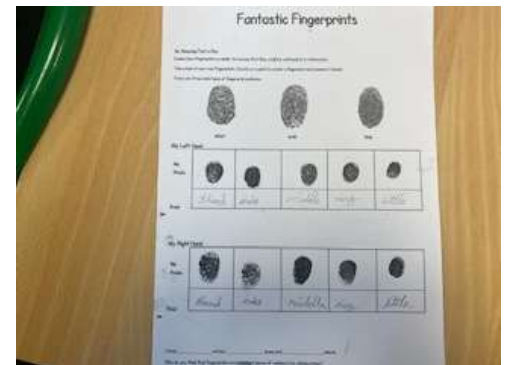
Last Friday Latymer All Saints was the scene of a mysterious 'who done it'!
