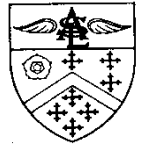

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, Latymer All Saints C of E Primary School had an Ofsted inspection on the 10th and 11th December 2024. Ofsted no longer gives an overall grade to schools, instead from September 2024, a judgement for each of the following areas is given:

- Quality of Education **Good**
- Behaviour and Attitudes **Good**
- Personal Development **Good**
- Leadership and Management **Good**
- Early Years Provision **Requires Improvement**

We are delighted to inform you that Latymer All Saints has been awarded 'Good' judgements by Ofsted in our latest inspection in all areas with the exception of our Early Years Provision that was awarded 'Requires Improvement'.

The verbal feedback given to the Senior Leadership Team, Governing Body and School Improvement Partners was extremely positive and captured the progress and successes of the school in the last term. We are extremely pleased that the hard work of our staff has been recognised, and I am sure you will join me in congratulating everyone who works at and with our school.

The written report is a 'point in time' of the two days that they visited and we are so joyful that they were able to capture the fabulous work of our school community.

The Ofsted report highlights all areas of provision at the school; I would like to draw your attention to the following feedback we received in the report:

- ✚ This is a highly inclusive school (where) pupils are welcomed and valued as unique individuals (and) the school's values of 'Love, Aspiration, Service' are embodied in the actions of staff.
- ✚ Leaders and staff put the best interests of pupils at the heart of everything they do (and) has high expectations of pupils' achievement (so) overall, pupils achieve highly, particularly in Reading and Maths.
- ✚ The development of pupils' character is a strong feature of school life. The school provides a broad (range) of experiences outside of the classroom to enrich the curriculum, such as clubs, educational visits and fundraising activities.
- ✚ Pupils from Reception onwards follow a Phonics programme that increases their confidence and fluency with reading (because) well-trained adults provide effective support for pupils to catch up and keep up with their peers, (using) books (that) are closely matched to the sounds they know.
- ✚ In most subjects, leaders have designed a well-sequenced and ambitious curriculum.

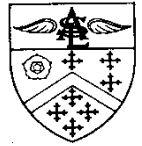

Some areas of development for us as leaders include:

- More work being done in our Early Years provision for the children to experience a high-quality curriculum so that children can develop the knowledge they need across all the areas of learning.
- Subjects in the wider curriculum which were recently revised, to become embedded by providing support for staff to develop their confidence to implement the changes consistently.

The areas of development that were mentioned are issues that we are aware of and the professional dialogue with Ofsted confirmed that, as a school, we have a clear vision for the school and that if we continue, we are on a pathway to excellence. The areas of development will continue to be a priority for our school going forwards.
