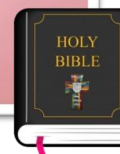
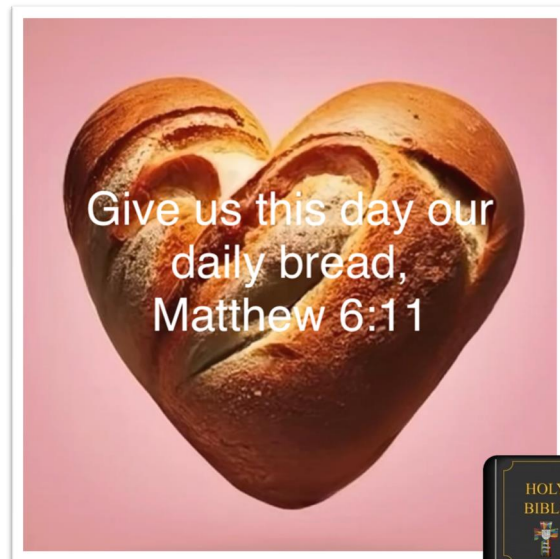

This half term **Year 6** children were studying the book: **The Arrival by Shaun Tan**. They started the new term by finding a strange suitcase in their classroom. Children had to ask questions around the suitcase and try and infer why it could be there.

Year 3 children familiarised themselves with life under a circus tent. They got the chance to experience the bright colours, noise and spectacle that add up to a mix of skills, humour and excitement inside a 'Big Top.' They experienced what it is like to walk a tightrope and run around the circus ring.

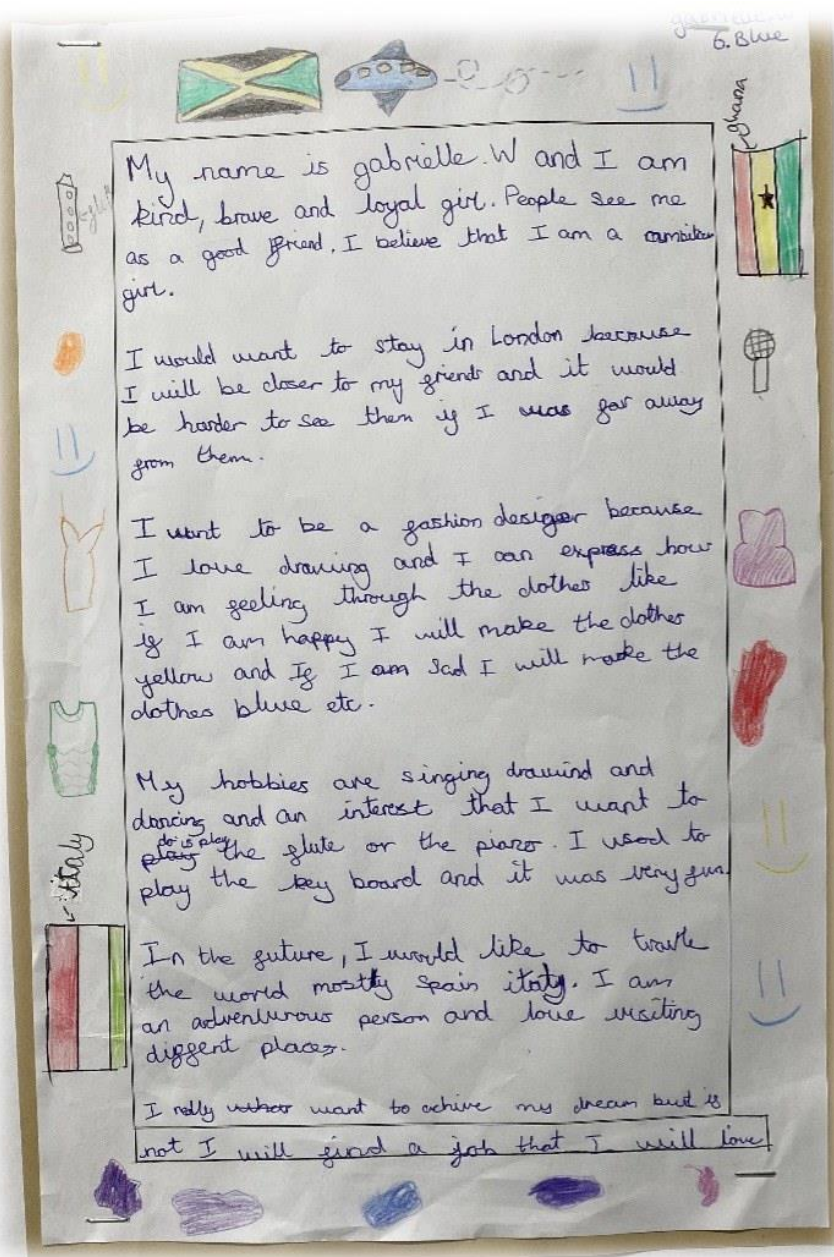
Year 2 were amazed to come into class and discover that someone had eaten all the porridge. They were not impressed with the mess that the offending person had left!!

Celebrate Your Hair!



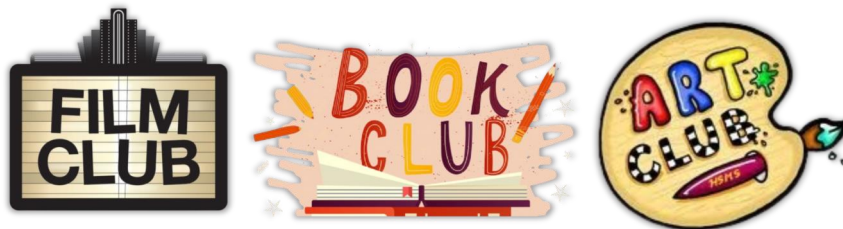
