Home Learning

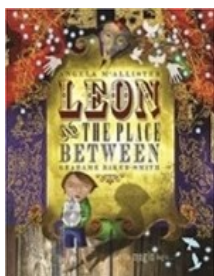
Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their homereader. They should read for 10-15 minutes daily and complete their home reading record.

Music

Let Your Spirit Fly RnB and other styles.
They will learn:

- How to listen and appraise a song
- build on your knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music
- Vocal warm ups and singing

Maths

In Maths, Year 3 will learn about:

- Place value
- Portioning
- Estimating numbers up to 1000 on a number line
- Comparing numbers up to 1000
- Adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers

Science

Children will be learning about Animals, including humans.

Studying the human skeleton, they will identify key bones and compare them to other animals explaining the role within the body.

Children will explore how changes in muscles result in movement and the implications these discoveries have in the scientific development of prosthetic limbs.

History

In our History lessons, children will be learning about The Egyptians. We will look at:

- How Egypt changed through time - kingdoms, art, pyramids, beliefs and writing
- the role of the Nile in developing belief systems as well as agriculture
- How the power structures (pharaohs, the double crown) were linked to the geography of Egypt

English: Reading

In Year 3 all children take part in daily Literacy Leaves lessons (reading comprehension). These sessions concentrate on different reading skills each day—summarising, inference, word meaning, retrieval, prediction, identifying meaning, understanding author choice and making comparisons.

English Writing

In Writing lessons, children will explore the different ways to extend their sentences. They will use: subordinating and co-ordinating conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and think carefully about their vocabulary choice.

DT

In Year 3 children will draw and label a simple castle that includes the most common features. They will recognise that a castle is made up of multiple 3D shapes.

They will design a castle with key features which satisfy a given purpose and utilise skills needed to build a complex structure from simple geometric shapes. Finally they will evaluate their work by answering simple questions.

PSHCE

This half-term, children will be learning:

- Being me in the world
- Celebrating difference
- Dreams and goals
- Being and keeping safe and healthy
- Building positive and healthy relationships

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be learning:

- How to stay safe online
- Understanding what a flowchart is and how flowcharts are used in computer programming
- Understanding what an algorithm is
- They will create a program using a given design

RE

What is the Bible's Big Story? They will investigate:

- What do the concepts Creation and Fall mean and how do they fit into the big story?
- What does the concept People of God mean and how does it fit into the big story?
- What does the concept Incarnation mean and why is it so significant to the big story?
- What does the concept Gospel mean and how does it fit into the big story?
- What do the concepts Salvation and Kingdom of God mean and how do they fit into the big story?

Geography

This half-term, children will be learning: How rivers get their water and how they shape the land. We will also learn all about wildlife in the river Severn and fishing, local agriculture and pollution problems.
