Home Learning

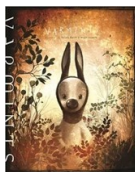
Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their home reader.

Homework Project: Your child will also receive a project that they can research during the holiday. The FITT Project will be based on autumn curriculum.

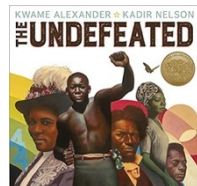

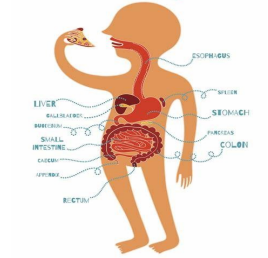

Drawing-Power prints

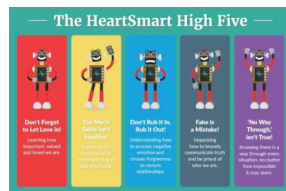
Methods, techniques, media and materials
