Maths: All children have access to Times Table Rockstars to practice their number work.

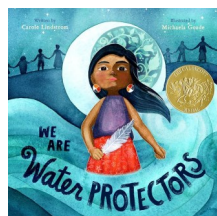
Homework : Children will be given homework every Friday, and it must be handed in on Wednesday.

This term, children will learn to appreciate differences, include others, and respond positively to bullying.

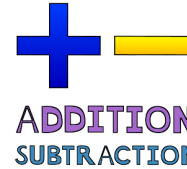

Children will create posters, lists, postcards, wanted posters, information reports, and short stories. The main outcome will be writing a persuasive letter.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about :

Living things and their habitats

- Microhabitats

This half term, Year 2 will learn to identify plants and animals, explore microhabitats and their conditions, and understand how these meet living things' needs. They will also discover what a botanist does.

Art and Design- Painting and mixed media

This unit focuses on primary and secondary colours, colour mixing, and creating textures using different tools. Pupils will explore collage techniques, experiment with materials, and evaluate their artistic choices. The aim is to develop understanding of colour, texture, and composition in art.
