Home Learning

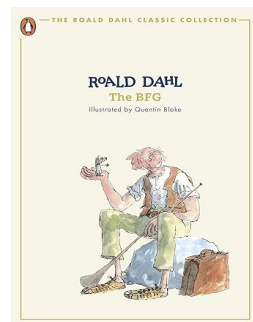
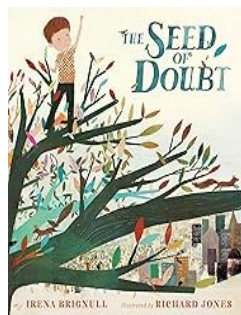
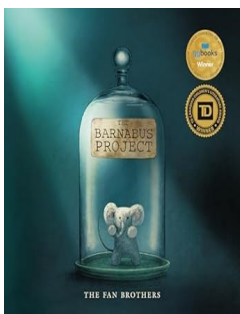
Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their homereader. They should read for 10-15 minutes daily and complete their home reading record.

Music

In Year 3 children will learn Glockenspiel Stage 1. Exploring & developing playing skills. They will:

- learn about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.
- learn to play and read the notes C, D, E + F.
- compose using the notes C, D, E + F.

Maths

In Maths, Year 3 will learn about:

- Multiplication—equal groups
- Using arrays
- Sharing and grouping
- Divide by 4 and 8
- 2, 4 and 8 times tables

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about **forces and magnets**. Children will be studying how to:

- Identify examples of pushes, pulls and twists.
- Define a force, including describing, naming and classifying contact and non-contact forces.
- Describe the relationship between friction and the roughness of a surface.

History

In our History lessons, children will be studying 'Cradles of Civilisation.' They will look at:

- The land of the two rivers
- Trade, building, writing
- Epic of Gilgamesh
- Similarities between civilisations

Geography

In Geography children will study 'Mountains.' They will learn:

- What mountains are?
- Why people live on mountains
- Living on the Andes

English Reading

In Year 3 all children take part in daily Literary Leaves lessons. These sessions concentrate on different reading skills each day—summarising, inference, word meaning, retrieval, prediction, identifying meaning, understanding author choice and making comparisons.

English Writing

In Writing lessons, children will be writing instructions and letters of advice. They will express time, place and cause using conjunctions. Children will also learn how to use the present perfect form of verbs instead of the simple past.

DT

In Year 3 children will learn all about the Digital World and wearable technology. They will learn how to problem solve by suggesting potential features on a micro:bit and justify their ideas. Children will also draw and manipulate 2D shapes, using computer aided design, to produce a point of sale badge. They will spend time learning how to develop design ideas through annotated sketches to create a product.

PSHCE

This half-term, children will be learning how to:

- Celebrate differences
- Accept that everyone is different
- Include others when working and playing
- Know how to help if someone is being bullied .
- Use kind words

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be learning all about coding. Children will learn:

- How to use flowcharts
- Select the right type of timer for a purpose
- How to use the repeat command
- To use coding knowledge to create a range of programs
