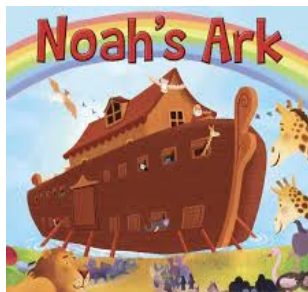
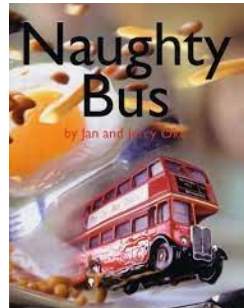
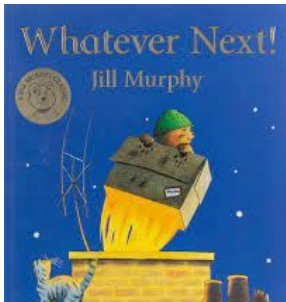

Literacy

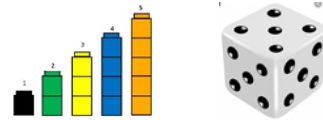
In **Nursery** the children will

- Understand the five key concepts about print:
 - print has meaning ,the names of the different parts of a book, print can have different purposes, page sequencing and we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom
 - Phonemic activities -count/clap syllables in a word / alliteration/oral blending.
- Children to be able to write the first letter of their name.

Mathematics

In Mathematics , **Nursery Children** will learn about

- Exploring and understanding number 3
 - Shapes - Focus on properties of shapes
 - Exploring and understanding number 4
 - Exploring and understanding number 5
- Singing number songs

Physical Development

In **Nursery** Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.

Be increasingly independent in meeting their own care needs, e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing and drying their hands thoroughly.

Expressive Arts and Design

In the arts, Nursery children will

- Making different marks and giving meaning.
- Hearing and listening to music. Being able to distinguish between the sounds of instruments.
- Vocalising and singing songs and rhymes as well as making up their own songs.
- Moving in different ways in response to music – claps/moves to a beat.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half-term Nursery children will:

- Play with one or more other children, extending and elaborating play ideas.
