Home Learning


Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and parent/carer should comment and sign.

In Year 1, .

English Writing

In Writing lessons, the children are going to write recounts of stories from their lesson text— they will also build upon their understanding of grammar and sentence structures. .

Maths

Science
