Home Learning


Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their homereader. They should read for at least 20 minutes each day.

English: Reading

We begin the year by reading 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake. This is a wonderful adventurous story with lots of opportunities for writing.

We will then explore the classic novel 'James and the Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl.

English Writing

The children will develop their own characters and write setting descriptions.

Maths

In Maths, Year 3 will learn about place value, addition and subtraction. We introduce column method, crossing 10 and exchanging.

Children are encouraged to use manipulatives, such as base 10, to support their learning and to be able to understand and represent larger numbers.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about plants and their requirements for growth.

The children will have the opportunity to explore the school's Edible Garden.

We will be setting up our own observation and finding out how water is transported through plants.

Geography

Year 3 will be travelling to Capel Manor Gardens to explore the variety of plants that grow there.

RE Big Question

Are roots important?

Art & DT

In Year 3 we paint with water colours.

Children will learn to use the layering method.

They are also taught how to draw using vanishing point.

We will also learn about the use of slider and lever mechanisms which we will use to create our own pop up books and moveable insects!

PSHCE

This half-term, children will be learning about ways that they can be kind to one another and identifying those around them who can help them when they are in need.

In the latter part of the half term, Year 3 will begin to look at Black History.

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be coding!

Children will spend time, understanding how codes work and will be encouraged to modify them - changing and adding codes and re-running the program to view the impact of their changes.

RE

This half-term's RE focus is a study around the question — What is the Bible's big story?

We will look at the overarching storyline that flows throughout all the books of the Bible, tying them together into one grand story.
