Home Learning


Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their home reader.

English: Reading

Our Daily Focused Reading sessions based around our

Topic: 'Transport and Trade.' The aim is to improve specific reading skills such as inference, retrieval and vocabulary.

English Writing

Throughout the unit, we have extended writing sessions which apply the use of skills such as varied sentence structures, speech marks and literary devices. The children will write instructional texts.

Maths

In Maths, Year 4 will be focusing on multiplication and division as well as length, perimeter and fractions.

We will emphasise the use of math resources, partner talk and encourage the children to use mathematical vocabulary when explaining their thinking. In multiplication and division, we will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be comparing and grouping a range of materials together according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. They will observe that some materials change state when the are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).

History / Geography

In our Humanities lessons, children will be focusing on geography. The children will develop their map skills as they plot Phileas Fogg's route around the world and compare with how modern travel would alter this. They will explore sustainable travel options and then plan their own journey around London on bus, overground, underground, Thames Clipper, DLR and cable car.

Our this Spring 1:

Our topic this half term is 'Transport and Trade' which is a Geography and History topic.

Big Question:

Do you know where you are going? Psalm 119 v 105

Your word is a lamp to guide me and a light for my path.

Music, Art & DT

In Year 4 this half term we will focusing on learning to play the recorder with Miss Morgan. This will include reading musical notation and a performance show.



PSHE

This half-term, children will be learning what forgiveness is and how to forgive others. Furthermore, they will learn that they are different types of stress, good and bad. They will recognise positive and negative stress including how to manage it.

Computing and Digital Learning

The children will then move on to learning about spreadsheets using Purple Mash. They will explore how data can be entered into cells, sort data and then turn it into a graphical representation.

RE

This half-term's RE focus is: Jesus I Am Sayings

BIG Question – Who is Jesus?

The children will be exploring who Jesus is through his I am Sayings, for example, 'I am the bread of life, I am the Resurrection'. To know how the statements may be relevant and applied to their own lives.
