Maths: All children have access to **Times Table Rock Star** to practice their times tables.

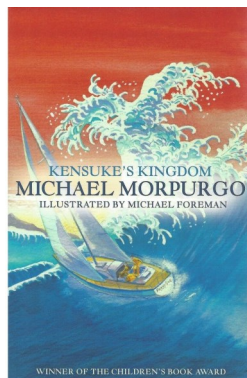
Purple Mash: Your child may also receive homework set by the teachers via Purple Mash. Any issues please contact your child's teacher.

English: Reading

Our Daily Focused Reading is based on our Topic: Whose Kingdom is it? We aim to improve reading skills such as inference, retrieval and vocabulary.

English Writing

Throughout the unit, we have extended writing sessions where we use varied sentence structures, speech marks and literary devices. The writing is based around our termly theme.

Maths

In Maths, Year 5 will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction. We emphasise the use of math resources, partner talk and encourage the children to use mathematical vocabulary when explaining their thinking. In place value we will be working with numbers up to million including Roman Numerals. In addition and subtraction, we will be working with four digit numbers and solving multi-step word problems.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about properties and changes of materials. This involves understanding the characteristics of different materials (such as glass, wood and metals) and exploring how and why they are used in our everyday lives.

Science is taught through Science Stories, investigations and experiments.

History / Geography

The focus for this half-term will be Geography.

In our Humanities lessons, children will be exploring countries on a world map and learning about their human and physical geographical features. This will be linked to the topic text, Kensuke's Kingdom (By Michael Morpurgo) and the route the main character travelled as he and his family sailed across the globe.

Our AUTUMN 1 Topic is:

Whose Kingdom is it?

Matthew 6 v 10, & 13 v 45-46

Music, Art & DT

Art

Art will be inspired by the Japanese artist Hokusai. We will paint a range of landscapes in the style of the artist as well as sculpting sea shells with clay.

Music

Children will learn to play and sing a famous Japanese piece (Sakura) on a pentatonic scale.

PSHE

This half-term, children will learn about how can we use our power in positive and negative ways. For example leaders who lead by example and those that simply dictate.

We explore this subject through a range of activities such as: whole class discussions, Circle Time, role play and writing.

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be learning how to stay safe online and how to navigate safely through social media.

They will also learn how the internet works including the binary codes.

RE

This half-term's RE focus is Christian liturgy which explores different church's patterns of worship. This will include a visit to our local church where a member of the clergy will explain the various roles and rituals that take place in a church service. The children will have an opportunity to prepare questions they would like to ask the Reverend. In small groups, children will write their own liturgy.
