English: Reading

Our Daily Focused Reading sessions will be based around our Topic: Achievements and Legacies. The aim is to improve reading comprehension skills.

English Writing

Throughout the unit, we have extended writing sessions which apply the use of skills such as varied sentence structures, speech marks and literary devices. The writing is based around our termly theme.

Maths

In Maths, Year 5 will be focusing on multiplication and division as well as fractions. We emphasise the use of math resources, partner talk and encourage the children to use mathematical vocabulary when explaining their thinking. In multiplication and division, we will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 as well as prime, cube and square numbers. In fractions, we will be recognising equivalents and converting between mixed numbers and improper fractions.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about properties and changes of materials. This involves understanding the characteristics of different materials (such as glass, wood and metals) and exploring how and why they are used in our everyday lives.

Science is taught through Science Stories, investigations and experiments.

History / Geography

The focus for this half-term will be History.

In our Humanities lessons, children will be researching the ancient civilisations of: Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece, Ancient Rome and the Kingdom of Benin. We will be focused on particular themes such as religion, science, sports and culture. We will carry out a comparison study among these four ancient civilisations.

Our AUTUMN 2 Topic is:

Achievement and Legacies

Colossians 3 v 23-24

Music, Art & DT

<u>Art</u>

We will be exploring how Christmas themes are represented in different art forms. Children will have an opportunity to create a piece of art work through painting or sculpture.

Music

Children learn about the history of music from its origins to present day. At the end of term, year 5 learn a traditional Christmas song and go carolling around the school.

PSHE

This half-term, children will learn about physical and mental well being such as sleeping well, how to deal with peer pressure, bullying and the importance of making the right choices. Every week, the class will have an opportunity to discuss any issues, or raise any questions they may have during Circle Time.

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be learning how to stay safe online and how to navigate safely through social media. They will also learn about online photographic editing to be aware of augmentations and how they could affect one's mental health.

RE

This half term the children will remember the sacrifice of those who gave their lives during World War I and II. Later on they will learning about the Nativity tale. They will investigate the origin of various traditions and the meaning of Christmas. This will also be taught through music and art.
