English: Reading

Our Daily Focused Reading is based on our Topic: Achievements and Legacies 2. We aim to improve the reading skills: inference, retrieval, vocabulary.

English Writing

Throughout the unit, we have extended writing sessions where we use varied sentence structures, speech marks and literary devices. The writing is based around our termly theme.

Maths

During the Spring term, Year 5 will be focusing on multiplication and division; fractions, decimals and percentages. We emphasise the use of maths resources and encourage the children to use mathematical vocabulary when explaining their thinking and engaging in partner talk. We will be working with four digit numbers to 1,000,000 as well as solving multi-step word problems.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be learning about Earth and Space. This involves describing the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the Sun in the solar system, as well as describing the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

Science is taught through Science Stories, investigations and experiments.

History / Geography

The focus for this half-term will be History.

In our Humanities lessons, children will be learning about the difference between the Suffragists and Suffragettes and their contribution to women's rights and equality. We will be focussing on notable figures both in history and the present day, like Emmeline Pankhurst and Malala Yousafzai.

Our Spring 1 Topic is:

Achievements and Legacies 2

Music / Art/ DT

The focus this half-term will be DT.

In Design and Technology we will be designing, and creating a rosette inspired by the historical work of the Suffragettes and Suffragists. Students will be practising their sewing skills during this unit.

PSHE

This half-term, children will learn how to manage difficult emotions like loneliness and who to turn to for support.

We explore this subject through a range of activities such as: whole class discussions, Circle Time, role play and writing.

Computing and Digital Learning

In Computing lessons, children will be learning about 3D modelling, databases and creating games.

They will be exploring programmes in the digital world to enhance their skills in designing games and applications; searching for information and creating databases.

RE

This half-term's RE focus is Islam, specifically the five pillars and how Muslims use these to express their faith and show their commitment to God.

Students will be learning about the importance of The Shahadah, Salah, Zakat, Hajj, Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Adha to Muslims.
