English: Reading

Our Daily Focused Reading sessions based around our Topic: 'Transport and Trade 2.' The aim is to improve specific reading skills such as inference, retrieval and vocabulary.

English Writing

Throughout the unit, we have extended writing sessions which apply the use of skills such as varied sentence structures, features of an information text and literary devices. The children will write non-chronological texts.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, Year 4 will be focusing on multiplication and division as well as length, perimeter, fractions and decimals

We will emphasise the use of math resources, partner talk and encourage the children to use mathematical vocabulary when explaining their thinking. In fractions, we will be making the link between fractions and decimals using the place value chart.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be will be learning about reversible and irreversible changes. They will investigate melting and boiling points of water including an understanding of the water cycle. Please encourage your children to read science books and watch appropriate videos to help support your child to understand these concepts.

History / Geography

In our Humanities lessons, children will be focusing on geography. The children will develop their map skills as they note the routes of the famous Silk Road and compare with how modern travel has altered this. They will explore trade within and between various empires such as the Egyptian, Roman and Greek eras.

This will include a visit to the famous tea Clipper ship, The Cutty Sark at Greenwich.

Our this Spring 2:

Our topic this half term is 'Transport and Trade 2' which is a Geography and History topic.

Big Question: Is Money Everything? 1 Timothy 6 v 10

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Music, Art & DT

In Year 4 this half term we will focusing on learning to play the recorder with Miss Morgan. This will include reading musical notation and a performance show.



<u>PSHE</u>

This half-term, children will be learning what forgiveness is and how to forgive others. Furthermore, they will learn that they are different types of stress, good and bad. They will recognise positive and negative stress including how to manage it. Furthermore, we will focus on the big television project Eat them to Defeat Them!. A campaign to encourage our children to eat vegetables stay healthy and safeguard their teeth.

Computing and Digital Learning

The children will learn about how to write for different audiences using programs such as 2Publish and 2Simulate. Later on, they will practice coding using Scratch.

<u>RE</u>

This half-term's RE focus is What is Holy Communion and How Does it build a Christian Community.

BIG Question – How Does Holy Communion Build Community
