Home Learning


Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and parent/carer should comment and sign.

English: Reading

The children will be taking part in daily reading groups using the Little Wandle scheme for reading. They will also take part in daily phonics sessions lasting atleast 30 mins. During this session they will practice new sounds and words as well as reviewing old ones.

Our text for this half term is, 'A Squash and a Squeeze' by Julia Donaldson. The children will write animal fact-files, poetry, descriptions and a diary entry from the perspective of the old woman from the story.

<u>Maths</u>

In our maths lessons the children will be beginning to look at multiplication and division. They will explore these concepts practically using our maths resources and draw pictures to help them understand that repeated addition is multiplication.

This will enable the children to progress and move on to looking at simple fractions in a variety of contexts. They will again explore his practically to gain a good understanding.

Science

Our science topic will focus on materials and understanding their properties. We will be looking at everyday materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. The children will explore vocabulary to describe these materials.

The will work on sorting them and grouping them based on their physical properties.

History / Geography

The children will have the opportunity to explore a world map and look at the different animals that originate from those countries. They will continue to revise the names of the continents, and oceans.

Our Summer 1 Topic is:

Animal Antics



Music, Art & DT

There are lots of art and music opportunities for the children to enjoy. The children will learn to mix and use water colours to create pictures of different animals.

In our music sessions the children will listen to 'The Carnival of Animals' by Camille Saint Saens. The piece of music contains 14 movements and the children will explore them to see which animals it reminds them of.

<u>PSHE</u>

Our PSHE sessions will focus on self-care this half term. The children will start the term looking at how they can take care of their teeth and move on to understanding themselves. They will look at how they can take care of their mental health.

Children will explore the different ways they can deal with problems and resolve them using the help of a trusted adult.

Computing and Digital Learning

This half term the children will begin to explore coding. They will learn simple and debug simple programs.

Children will have the opportunity to use the Beebots and programme them to perform simple movements. They will build on their knowledge of giving simple, clear instructions and creating algorithms from last term.

As well as using the iPad, the children will have the opportunity to work practically with one another.

<u>RE</u>

In our RE sessions, the children will be learning about the stories of Jesus (parables). Some of the stories they will learn include; The lost sheep, The prodigal Son, The Parable of the Sower, The Foolish Builder and The Good Samaritan.

Children will learn to understand the key concept if Gospel and good news and explore lots of new vocabulary. During our lessons, children will hear passages from the Bible to accompany their learning.
