Home Learning

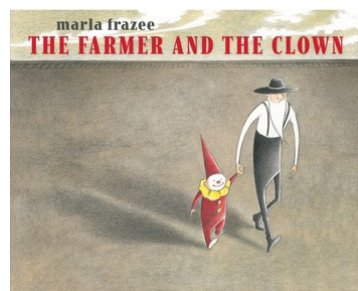
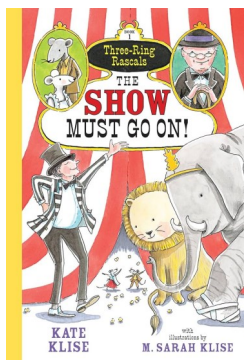
Reading: Children should complete their daily reading and complete their homereader.

English: Reading

Maths

In Maths, Year 2 will be practising for the upcoming Year 2 SATs and working on units of measure. The children will learn to measure length, capacity and mass through practical activities.

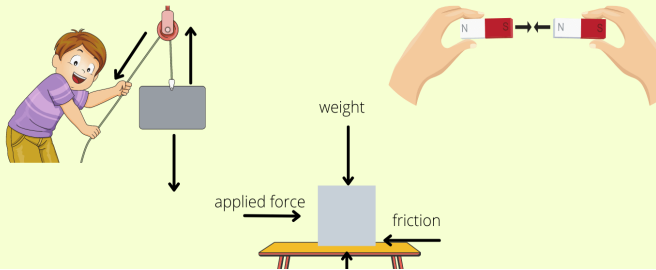
Science

The children look at animal offspring and compare them to their adults. Children look in detail at how humans change as they grow older, drawing on their own observations. They also cover the basic things that animals need for survival: water, food and air.

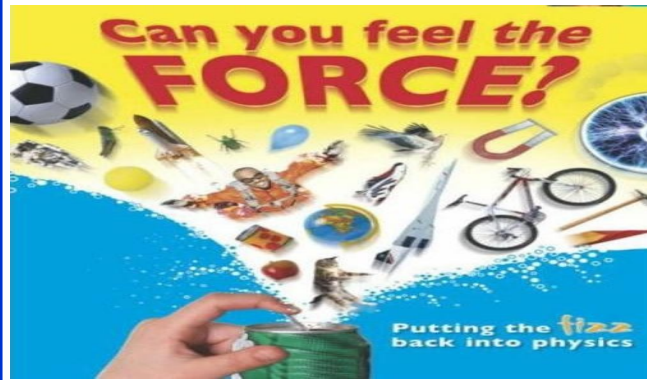
- We will also describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.
